

Getting to Huelva

Huelva is well served by both national and international transport links. The airports of Faro (Portugal) and Seville are one hour's drive away. There are train and bus links to all major Andalusian provincial capitals as well as Madrid.

Arriving in Faro:

If you travel from Faro to Huelva, you should travel with the companies Damas, Alsa or Eva Bus. You can check their web page in the following link:

Be aware that in Portugal there is one hour less than in Spain. There are also two daily buses: *Please check the timetables before your departure. There may be changes which are not reflected in this guide.*

Arriving in Seville:

If you fly from Seville you can take a taxi/bus to 'Plaza de Armas Bus Station'. There are two bus stations in Seville but the Plaza de Armas is the only one that serves Huelva. If you do not want to go by taxi, you can take the bus from the airport to the city centre (Airport Special Line, which costs 4 €). The bus stops in the train station (Santa Justa) where you can get by train to Huelva and you can also take an urban bus called C4, to go to the 'Plaza de Armas Bus Station'.

There are buses every hour from Seville to Huelva. Make sure you get a direct bus, which goes via the A49 motorway rather than the local villages route, the journey takes about an hour and 15 minutes. The price is around 8 euros.

Arriving in Madrid:

Please be aware that if you are taking a coach from Huelva to Madrid Barajas Airport you have to ask for a ticket to 'Barajas', not to Madrid.

Arriving in Málaga:
